## HEALTH COVERAGE: GOD'S PLAN COVERS ALL MY LIFE DEMANDS

*Isaiah 53:4-5* Surely, **he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows**; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the **chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.**

*Matt 8 NIV* <sup>16</sup> When evening came, **many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick** <sup>Acts 10:38</sup>.  
<sup>17</sup> **This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and bore our diseases."**

*Psalms 103 NIV* <sup>1</sup> **Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.**  
<sup>2</sup> **Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—**  
<sup>3</sup> **who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases,**  
<sup>4</sup> **who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion,**  
<sup>5</sup> **who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.**

One of the greatest benefits of our redemption in Christ is health, healing, and wholeness—not just of the body, but of the spirit and soul. This is God's will for every believer: to live holy and whole—spirit, soul and body <sup>1Thess 5:23, 3John 1:2</sup>.

Jesus Christ came to save us from sin and all its consequences, chiefly sickness and poverty. "You shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins" <sup>Matt 1:21</sup>. But the price He paid for sin also covered sickness. "Surely, He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows... and by His stripes we are healed" <sup>Isaiah 53:4-5</sup>. When He took our sins, He also took our sicknesses. When He bore our iniquity, He also carried our infirmity. Jesus' death and resurrection destroyed sin and death's power and purpose. Sin and death were designed to bring destruction, but Christ turned it into a doorway to redemption. Through faith in Christ, humanity is restored and elevated—we become partakers of the divine nature <sup>2Peter 1:4</sup>. Through his divine nature in us, we receive power over sin, sickness, disease and poverty.

Healing, however, is not merely physical—it flows from the inside out. "The spirit of a man will sustain him in sickness" <sup>Prov 18:14</sup>. "Guard your heart with all diligence, for out of it flow the issues of life" <sup>Prov 4:23</sup>. If it is well on the inside, it will be well on the outside. If it is not well within, no external cure will last. This is why sanctification must be whole: "May God sanctify you wholly—spirit, soul, and body" <sup>1Thess 5:23</sup>.

Health is not only individual—it is corporate. There is no personal healing without family, community, and national healing. As it is written: "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray... I will heal their land" <sup>2Chron 7:14</sup>. Our individual wellness is connected to the wellness of our homes, our cities, and our nations. "They shall prosper that love thee" <sup>Psalms 122:6</sup>. When we are spiritually aligned, physically restored, and relationally reconciled, then true healing flows. Divinity meets humanity, and the result is wholeness. This alignment begins with personal **conviction** of the redemptive work of Christ and the **confession** of our hope of healing and wholeness. Here are powerful Kingdom Health Coverage Realities:

**WEEK [2] We Are Healed and Restored by the WORD** <sup>Prov 18:21, Psalms 107:20, Prov 16:24, Psalms 50:4 Prov 10:11, Mark 11:23, Eph 4:19</sup>

Words have the power to heal or to harm, to build up or to break down. Why and how are words so powerful healing instruments?

1. Words are spirits -they carry life or death, healing or sickness
2. Words are verdicts -they execute judgements and make decrees, either for justification or condemnation
3. Words are messengers -they go to where there are sent and do what they are told
4. Words are seeds - they produce harvest when planted, those who love it will eat the fruits
5. Words are instruments -they make things happen or stop things from happening

# WORD MEDITATION - WEEK 25<sup>19</sup>

**SCRIPTURE READING** KJV, NKJV, AMP, NLT, MSG, GNT, TLB, ESV, THE VOICE

## Galatians 3 NIV

<sup>13</sup> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole.” <sup>14</sup> He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

**Exodus 15 NIV** <sup>26</sup> He said, “If you listen carefully to the Lord your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, who heals you.”

**Revelation 19 NIV** <sup>10</sup> At this I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, “Don’t do that! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers and sisters who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For it is the Spirit of prophecy who bears testimony to Jesus.”

**Revelation 12 NIV** <sup>10</sup> Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: “Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down.<sup>11</sup> **They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony;** they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.

**3John 1 AMP** <sup>2</sup> Beloved, I pray that in every way you may succeed *and* prosper and be in good health [physically], just as [I know] your soul prospers [spiritually].

**1Thessalonians 5<sup>23</sup>** Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you through and through [that is, separate you from profane and vulgar things, make you pure and whole and undamaged—consecrated to Him—set apart for His purpose]; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept complete and [be found] blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>24</sup> Faithful *and* absolutely trustworthy is He who is calling you [to Himself for your salvation], and He will do it [He will fulfill His call by making you holy, guarding you, watching over you, and protecting you as His own].
